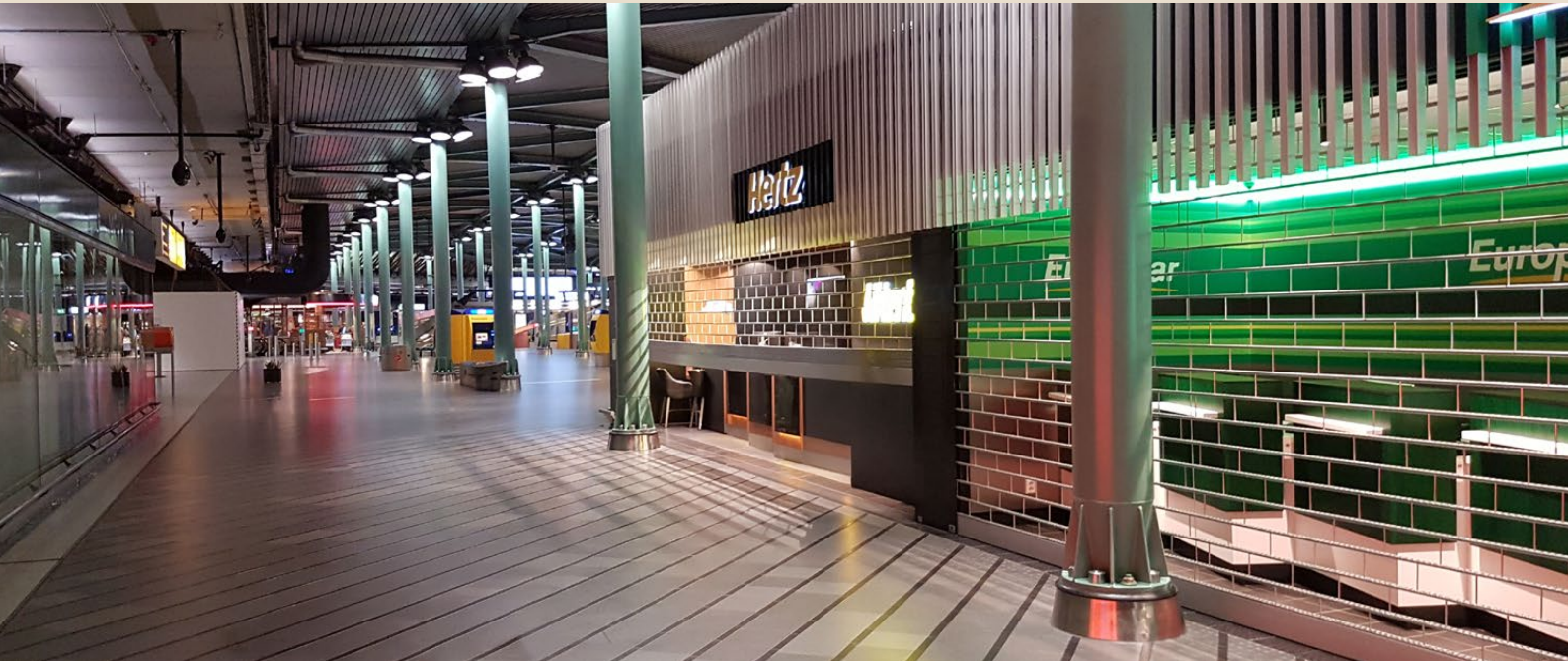

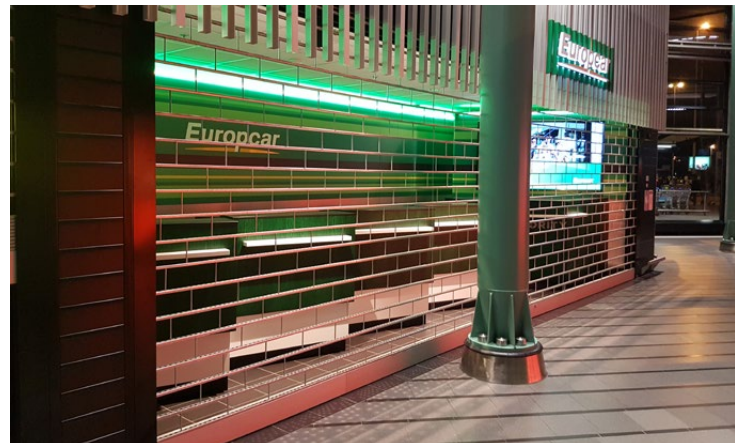
USING **STACKDOOR XXL** TO ZONE AT SCHIPHOL AIRPORT

At 27.87 km², and with six runways, Schiphol is the biggest airport in the Netherlands and is one of the biggest and busiest European airports.

The car rental desks at Amsterdam Schiphol Airport are located in Schiphol Plaza, the airport's main foyer that connects the departure and arrival halls.

Several rental companies have desks there including Avis, Budget, Alamo, Enterprise, Europcar and Hertz.

The zoning of areas in airports so that they cannot be accessed out of working hours is not uncommon, but in this scenario the car leasing areas to be shielded each spanned nearly 10 metres in width.



These dimensions are not achievable with a classic roller shutter or grille, or folding gates without having additional central supporting columns.

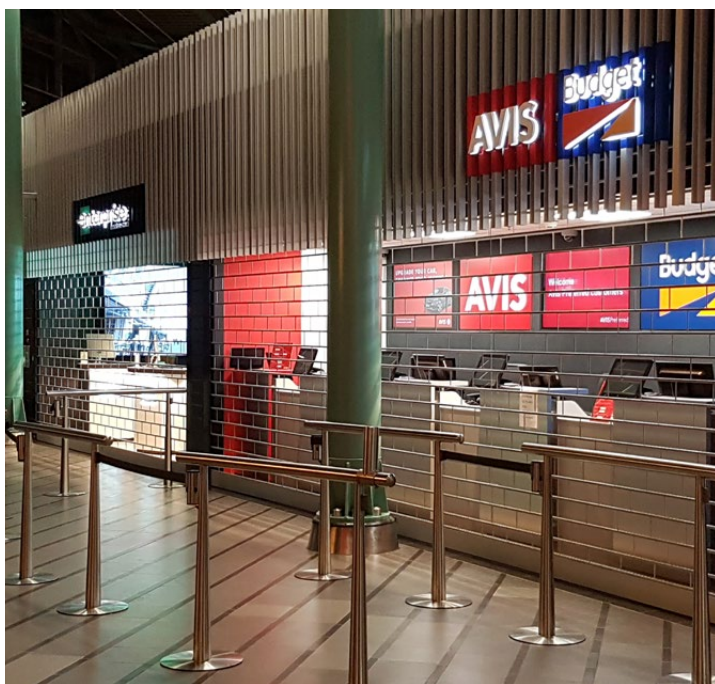


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Stackdoor Extra-Wide XXL was the perfect solution and 4 large stacking grilles of almost 10 metres each were made specifically for the site.

The small storage space required at the top of the opening enabled the stacking grilles to be completely hidden in the ceiling when open, and no supporting columns or potentially dangerous floor fixings were required.



Products used in this project

The lightweight Stackdoor XXL grilles are designed to give maximum visibility without compromising on security whilst the open structure maintains an attractive appearance.

The space-saving design takes up less space than **classic security shutters and compact stacking zone** means **no visible head box**.
